The "Roland W. Frei Award" sponsored by **IAEAC** will be given to the best poster presented by a junior scientist.

Two other poster Prizes in form of **Springer** book vouchers will be awarded, as well (two prizes of 150 EUR each).

The **SECyTA** will also support this event by providing scholarships for *SECyTA* members attending the conference.

### Main Topics:

- New analytical techniques (green, micro, sensor-based methods, biosensors, etc...) and strategies for the analysis of pesticides and related organic emerging pollutants.
- Trends in the analysis of transformation products. Recent developments in High Resolution Mass Spectrometry.
- Levels of residues of pesticides and emerging pollutants in water, sediments, soils, air, food, feed, agricultural products and biota.
- Occurrence, fate and behaviour of pesticides and related pollutants in the environment.
- Fate modelling in the environment.
- Natural removal processes of pesticides and related pollutants in the environment.
- Environmental protection and remediation techniques. Technology breakthrough for the removal of pesticides and emerging pollutants.
- (Eco)toxicity and environmental risk assessment.
- Policy relevance for the environment and food/feed safety.
